POLICIES

- 1. Youth are required to be in the designated buildings at all times and only permitted in designated areas.*
- 2. We only permit language that is positive toward one another (no cursing or degrading speech).*
- 3. Modest clothing must be worn at all times. Swimming attire must be modest swim trunks for males and modest one piece suits for females (no Speedos, cut-offs, or bikinis).*
- 4. Fighting is not permitted at any time.*
- 5. No public displays of affection are permitted. If in question, do not do it.*
- 6. No smoking, alcohol, illegal drugs, or weapons are permitted at any time.*
- 7. Students needing medication are required to place the medicine in “zip lock” bags marked with the student’s name and handed to one of their church group leaders to hold and distribute medication. This includes all prescribed and over the counter medication.*
- 8. Be sure to thank God for all the great times we will experience with Him and our brothers and sisters in Christ.*
